“Leaves of three, let them be.”

Contact with bare skin can cause:

- moderate to severe rash.
- moderate to severe blistering.
- a very unhappy two-three weeks.

You can get poison ivy from:

- clothes that have come in contact.
- pets that have walked through it.
- direct contact.

Identifying Poison Ivy

- Clusters of three leaves, typically pointy-ended.
- Leaves are sometimes shiny and/or reddish in appearance.
- Can be small plants or large “hairy” vines climbing trees.

Poison ivy is an unfortunate fact of life in New England fields and forests. Please learn to avoid it so you can continue to enjoy your time outdoors.
